KINDS OF NONFICTION

WHAT IS IT?

The 5 Kinds of Nonfiction classification system differentiates nonfiction books by their writing and design styles. The system helps librarians and educators expand and balance their nonfiction collections and provide a broad array of titles that appeal to different types of readers. See the five types on the following page.

WHO CREATED IT?

Award-winning author Melissa Stewart, in collaboration with educators and librarians.

WHY?

Studies show that educators tend to gravitate toward narrative nonfiction, but many kids are drawn to other, more expository types of nonfiction. This system helps students identify and select books they like, predict the type of information they will find in a book, and use the books for specific purposes.

WHERE CAN I FIND NONFICTION BOOKS BY TYPE?

Lerner has classified most of our nonfiction books using the 5 Kinds of Nonfiction system. In this catalog, look for the  symbol with the first letter of a category in the center. Some books may contain elements from two different categories; these are blended nonfiction titles. You can also visit lernerbooks.com/5KNF to search by category.

Note that books that deliver factual information but strongly use fictional elements—such as invented dialog or scenes, talking animals, or fictional characters—are not included in this classification system. These books have the text type “informational fiction.”
