Feronia Parker-Thomas was born and raised in South West England. She studied at Camberwell College of Art in London. She and her family now call Bristol home.



The Rabbi and the Reverend Joachim Prinz, Martin Luther King Jr., and Their Fight against Silence




Hannah G. Solomon Dared to Make a Difference







The Great Passover Escape






An Egg for Shabbat






This rhyming, rhythmic story follows a diverse group of Israeli children as they taste a variety of different ethnic foods found in Israel.

A Rainy Day Story


