## The Rabbi and the Reverend Joachim Prinz, Martin Luther King Jr., and Their Fight against Silence

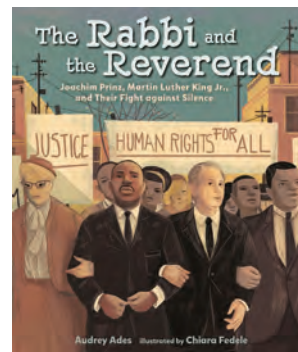

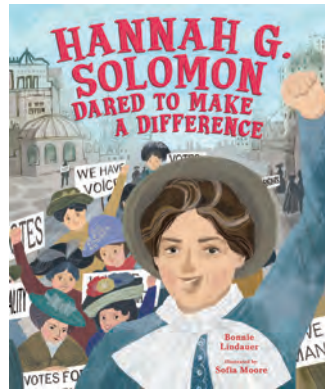
## Hannah G. Solomon Dared to Make a Difference

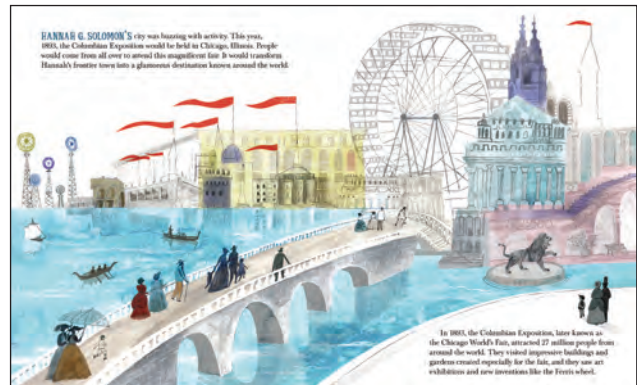

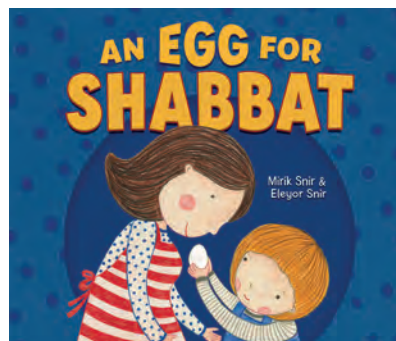
## An Egg for Shabbat
