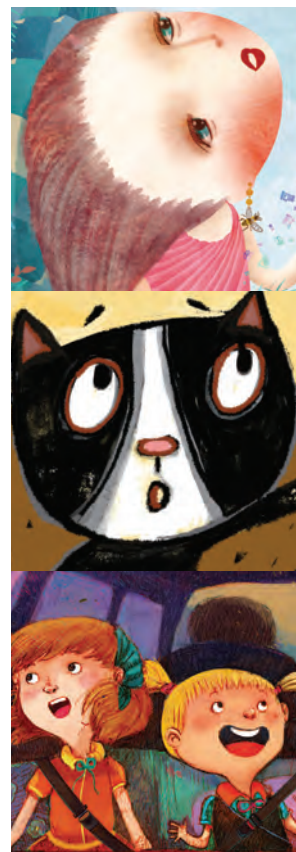

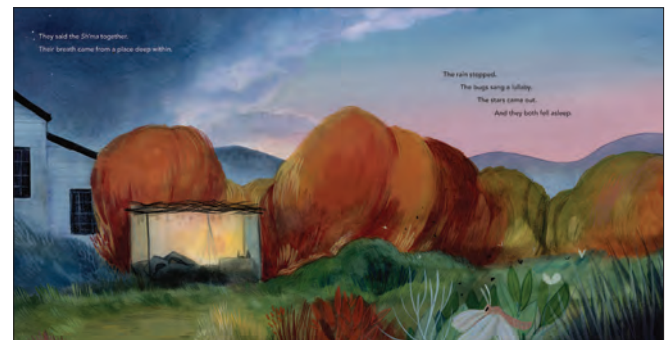

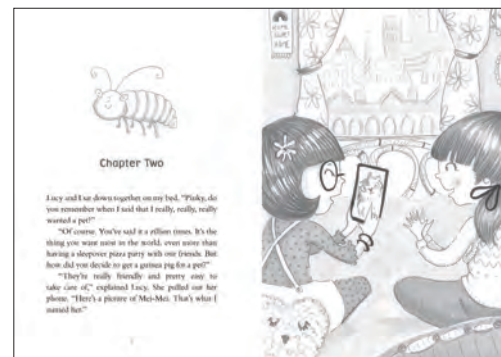

Tizzy the Dizzy Dreidel

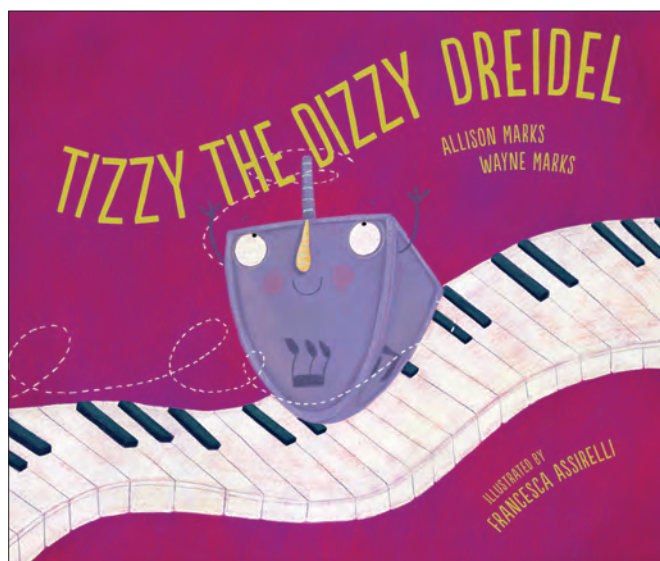

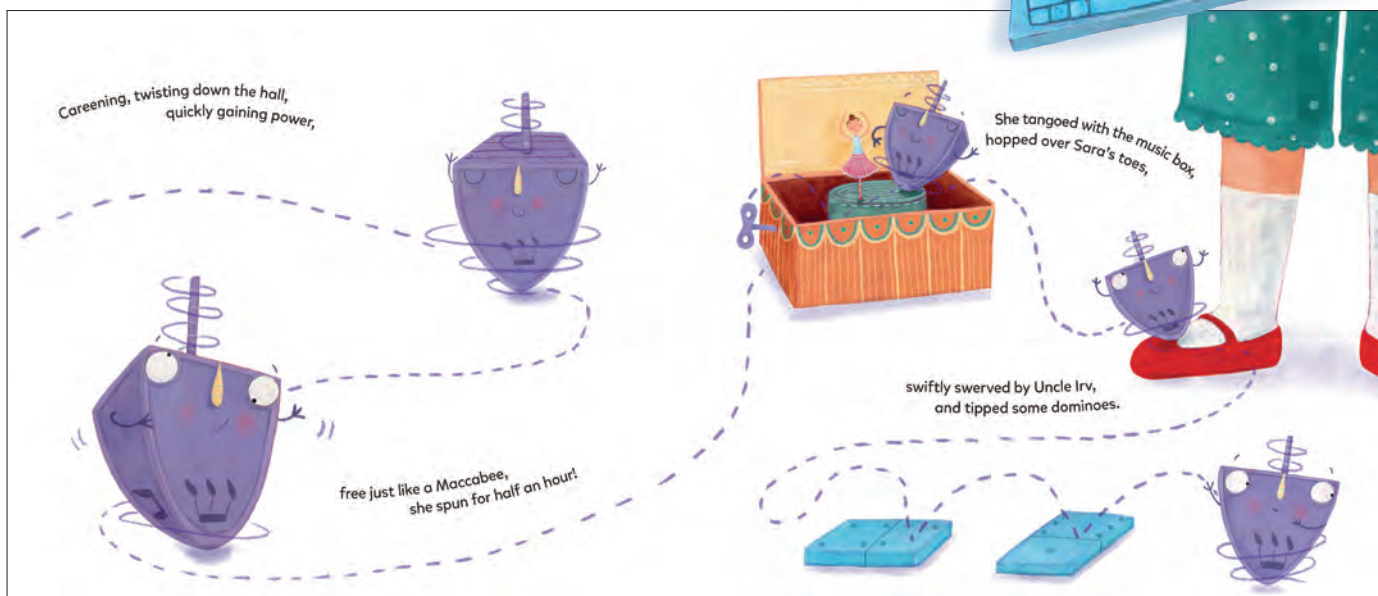

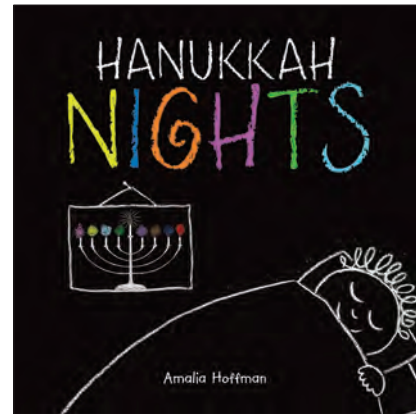


Hanukkah Nights

Hanukkah in Little Havana

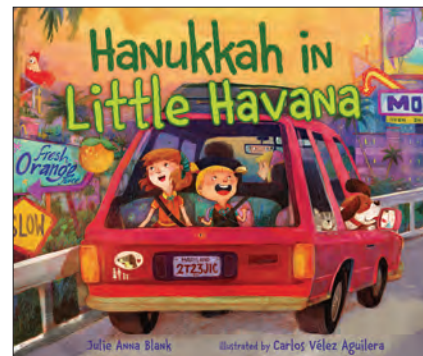

Professor Buber and His Cats

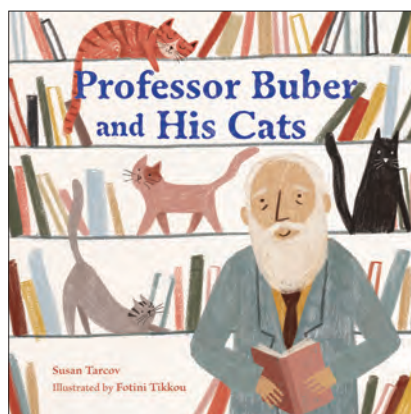

Deborah's Tree

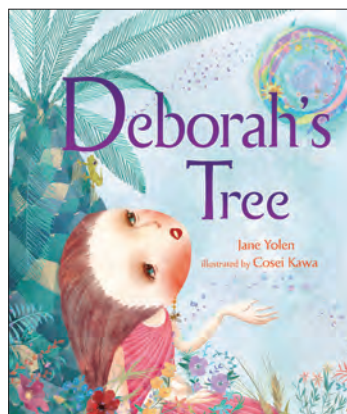

Shoham's Bangle

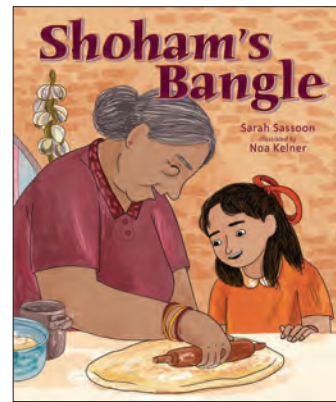

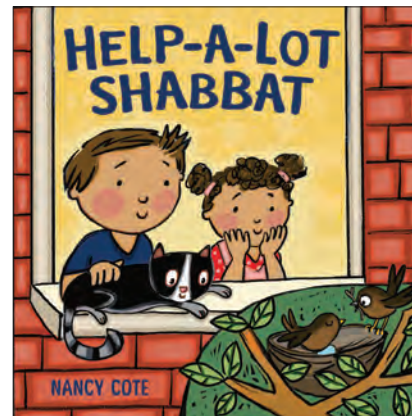


Help-A-Lot Shabbat

Jacqueline Jules is an award-winning poet and author of many books for children. She lives in northern Virginia.



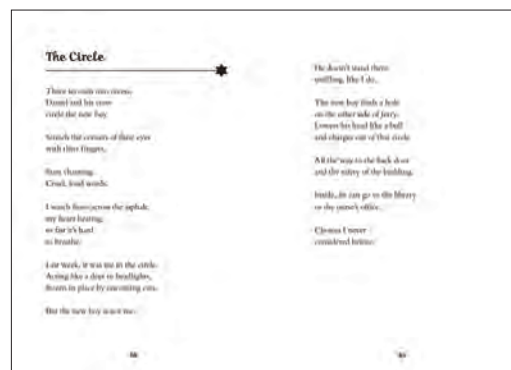

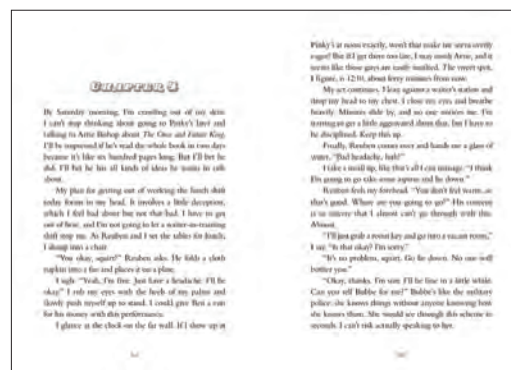

Raquela's Seder

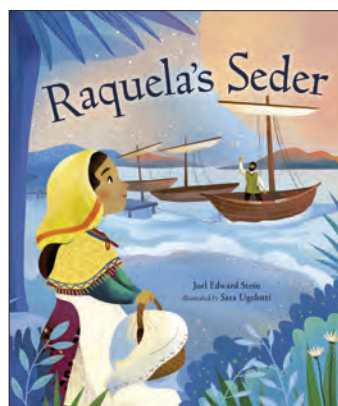

Frank, Who Liked to Build The Architecture of Frank Gehry

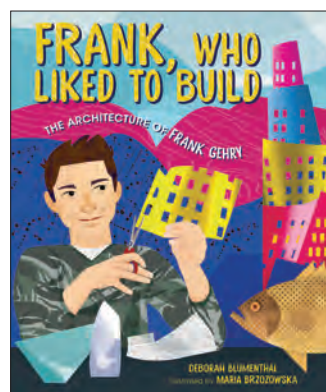
