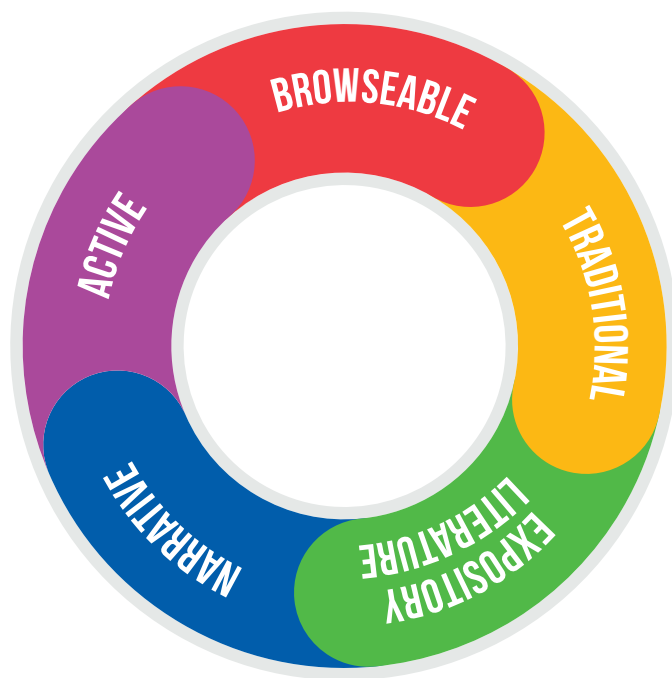
KINDS OF NONFICTION

Created by award-winning author Melissa Stewart, in collaboration with teachers and librarians, The 5 Kinds of Nonfiction classification system differentiates nonfiction books by their writing and design styles. The system helps educators provide a broad array of nonfiction titles that appeal to different types of readers.

Studies show that educators tend to gravitate toward narrative nonfiction, but many kids are drawn to other, more expository types of nonfiction. This system helps students identify and select books they like, predict the type of information they will find in a book, and use the books for specific purposes.

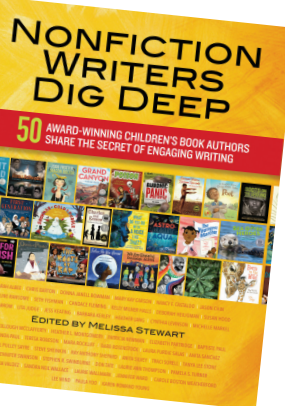
