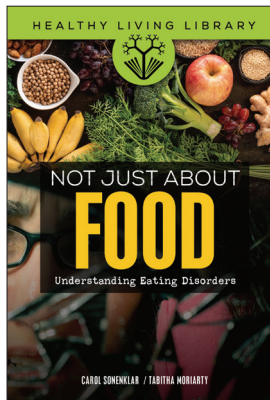
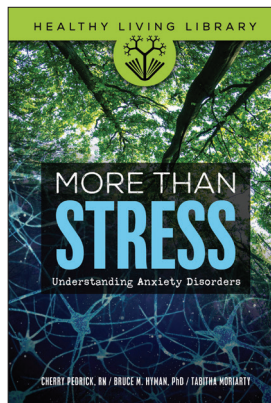
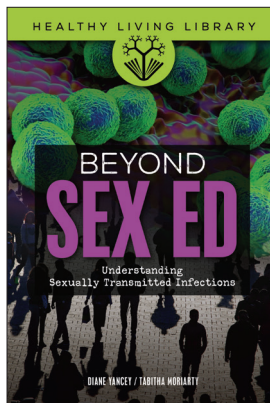
Wild goats and sheep were abundant in the hills of the ancient Middle East. By domesticating these animals, early Middle Eastern farmers obtained milk, meat, and wool. Because these animals have strong herding instincts, they were easier to domesticate than other animals. They tended to stay in groups and follow lead animals. They rarely ran or ran away.

Ancient Middle Eastern farmers learned to breed animals with desirable traits. If a farmer wanted big, even-tempered sheep that gave lots of milk, the farmer mated animals with those characteristics. The sheep that were smart, aggressive, or gave much milk were kept for breeding for more. Over

several generations of sheep, this led to herds of large, docile sheep that gave lots of milk.

The Plow

Plows broken or torn over soil to make long furrows, or trenches, in a field. Farmers plow seeds in these trenches so their plants grow in orderly lines. Plowing also helps control weeds and insect pests. Archaeologists think ancient Middle Eastern farmers made the first plows soon after they began farming.
