Sound Explorers

Some letters commonly make more than one sound. Exploring hard, soft, long, and short letter sounds and having that knowledge secure is an important skill for emergent students to master

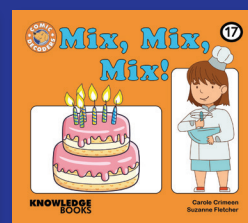
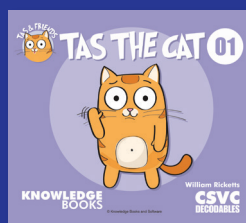
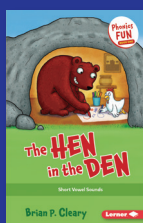
Step 1: Learn Letter Sounds
