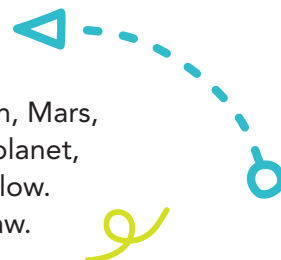

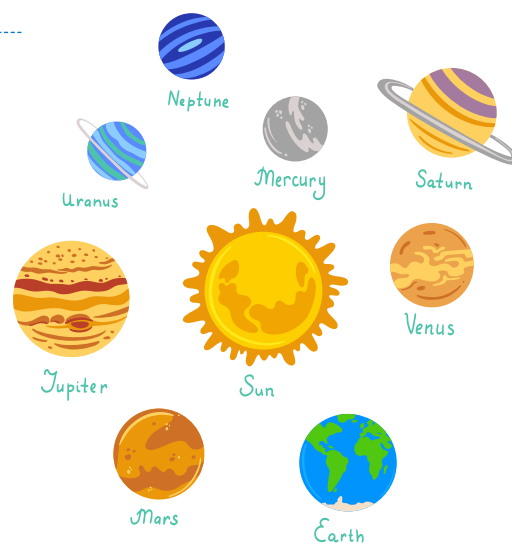
Out of This World

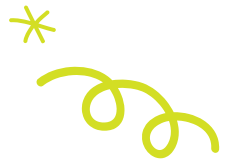

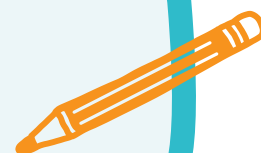
