

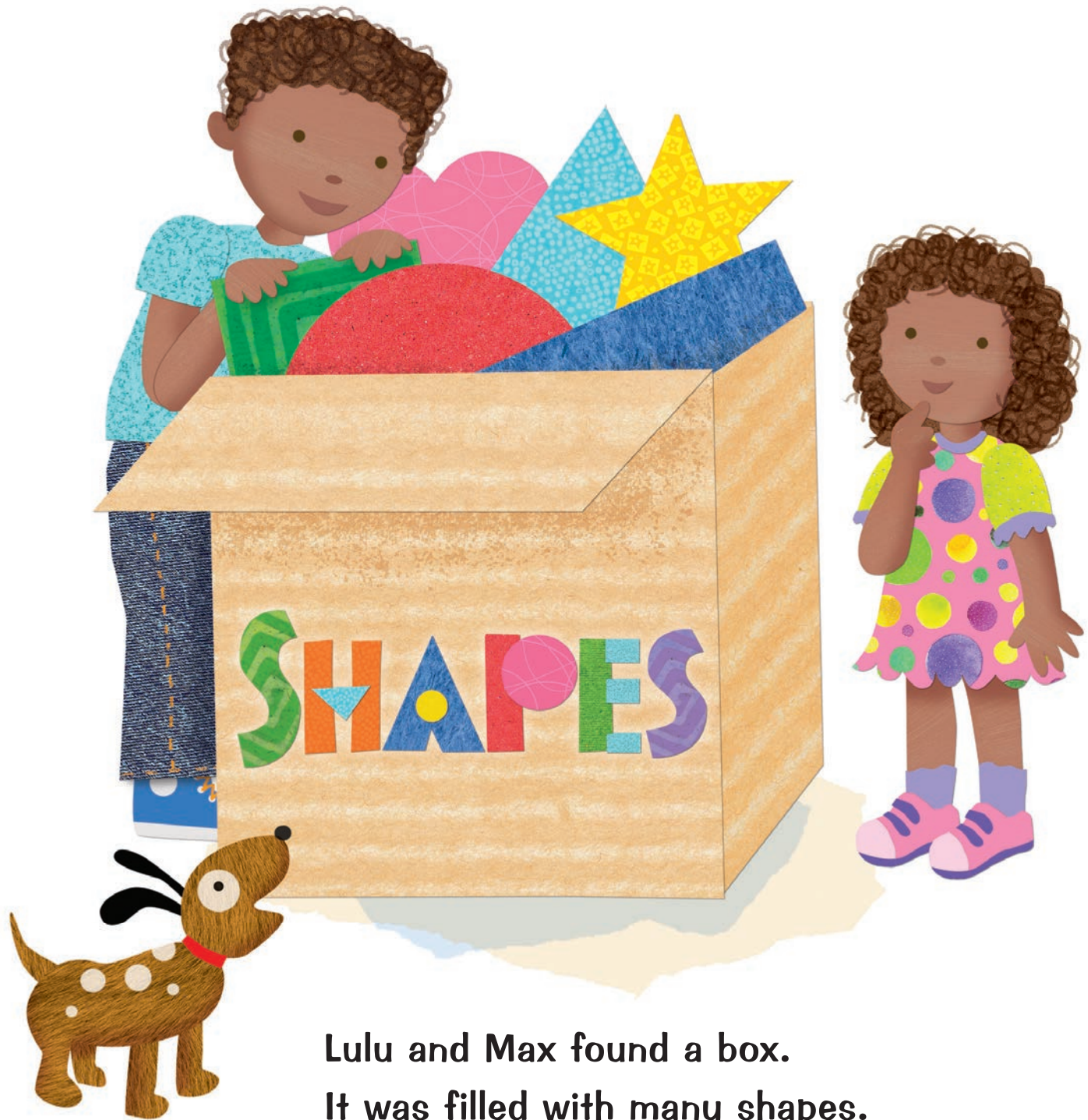

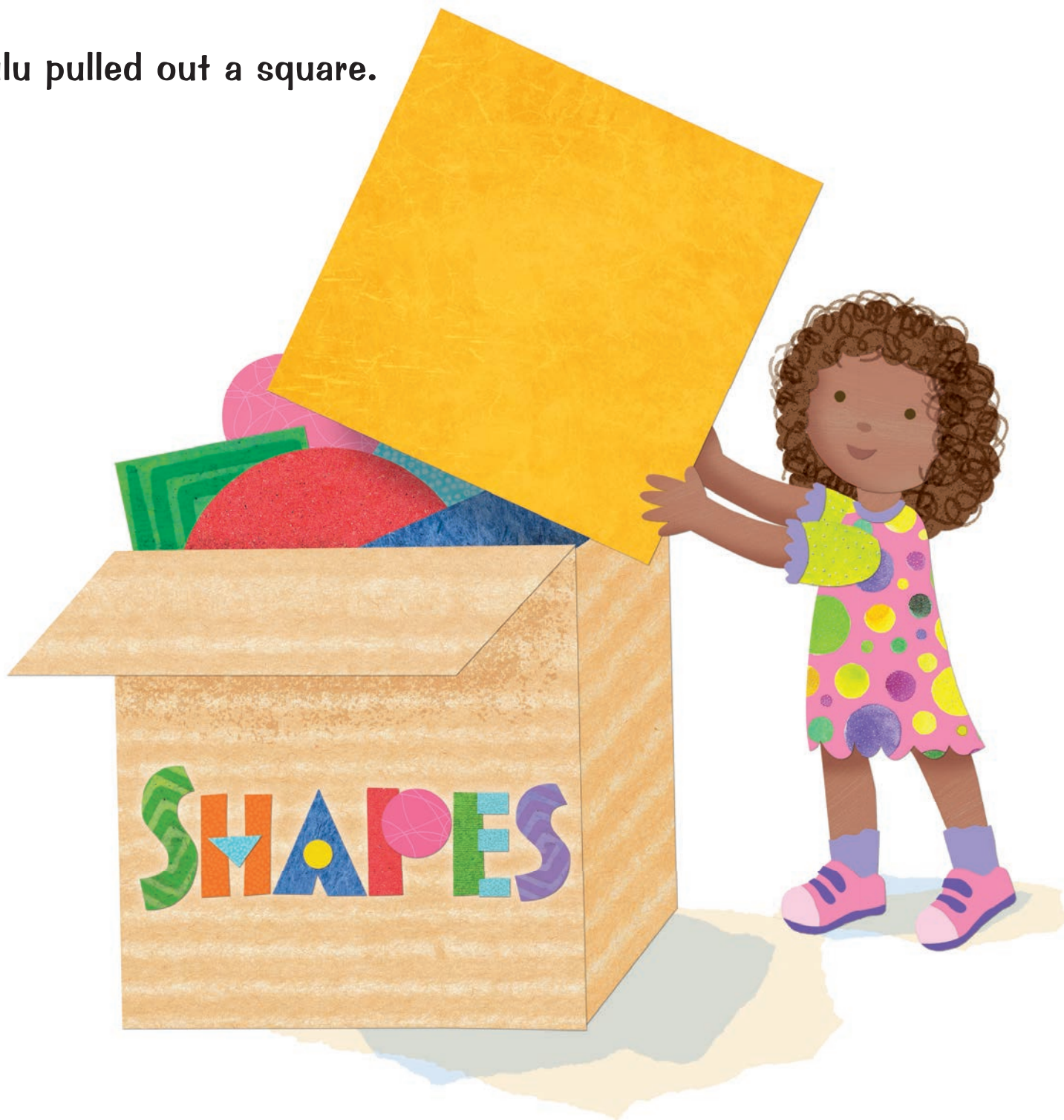

A house.

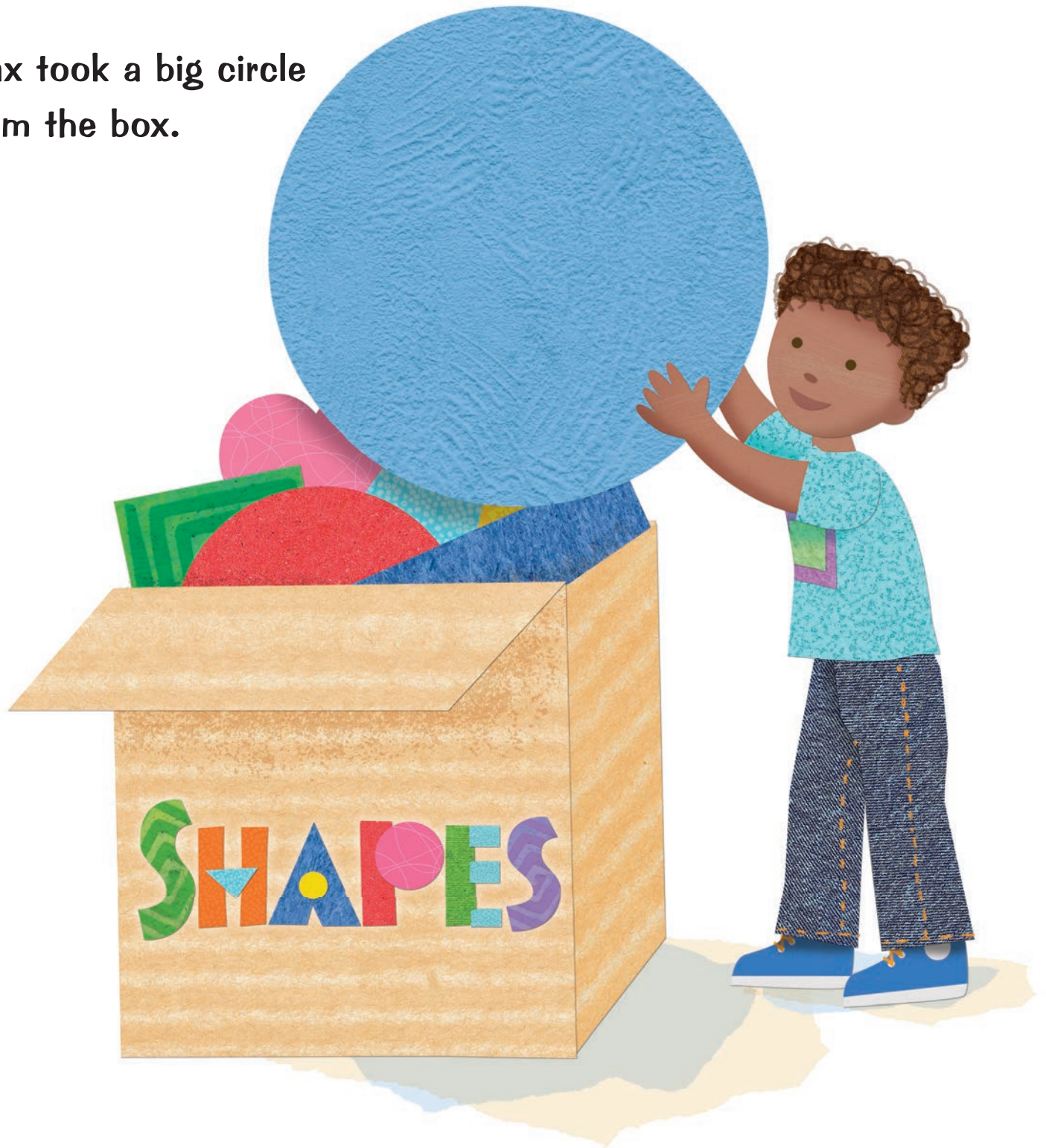




"I will live in the house with my

"Hmmm. What else can we make?"**





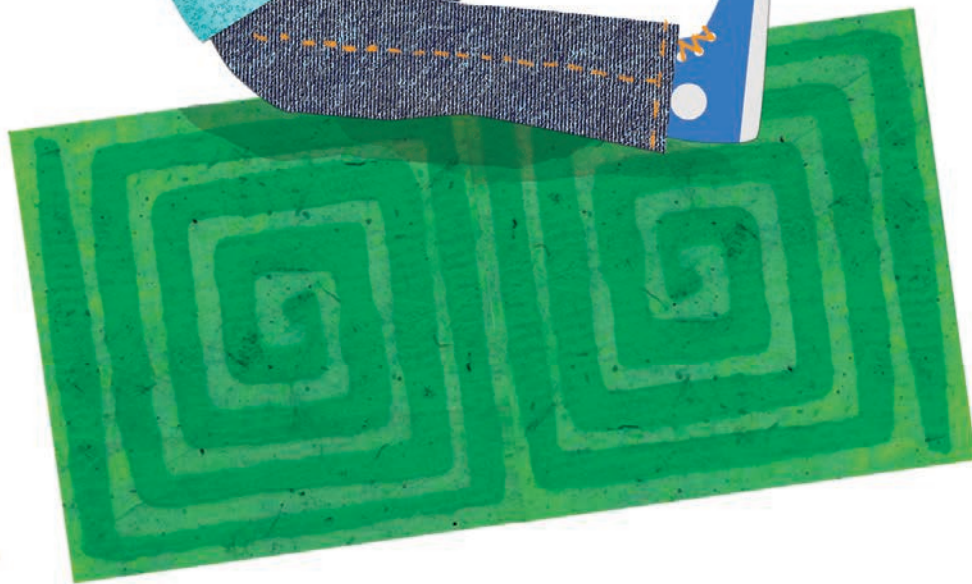
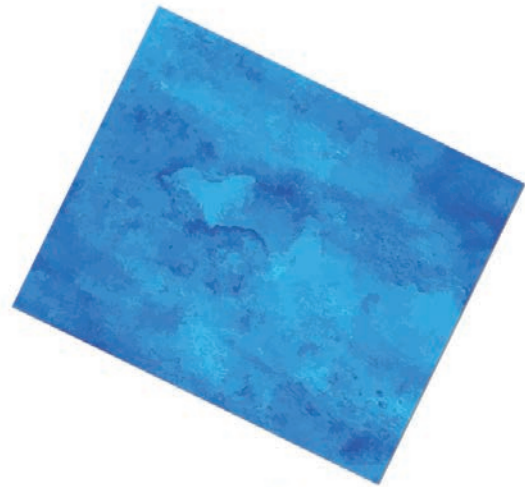
